Northeastern Center for the Arts Ideas & Projects Proposals:

Have a great idea for a project? You are invited to submit proposals for the development of creative projects, artist residencies, workshops, performances, and exhibitions. Projects should include significant student engagement and support CAMD's strategic priorities: *Creative Practice, Experience Design, Media Innovation & Society*.

- We require a minimum one-year lead time.
- Idea & Project proposals are accepted twice a year
- Proposals for Fall 2017 due ***Friday October 7th 2016***.
- Proposals for Spring 2018 due ***Friday February 3rd 2017***

How to Apply

Submit an application that includes:

Your Name & Contact Information

Along with a brief statement (2 pg MAX) describing your proposal.

Be sure to include information about

- Student & Faculty engagement
- How will fields of inquiry be advanced?
- How does project supports CAMD's strategic priorities?
- For Visiting Artists, what kind of event (lecture, performance, workshop, screening, etc) will be presented?

Proposals could also include:

- Preliminary Dates
- Preliminary Budget

Selection Committee: the CAMD Executive Committee will evaluate the proposals. Final project approval is subject to department chair approval.

Friday February 3rd 2017
